Mary Thanks You for Helping Fight Hunger

In 2022, fresh produce should be accessible to everyone. But for Mary, and thousands of others like her, it is often out of reach. The main obstacle the faces when it comes to grocery shopping, besides her extremely limited food income, are the 20 miles between her home and the nearest grocery store.

Mary has diabetes and needs fresh food to stay healthy. But, as an all-time, fresh food is often more expensive – and it certainly doesn't keep as well as processed food.

Mary also has a serious eye condition. The medical bills associated with this disease have

been putting an additional strain on her monthly Social Security benefits, which already don't last the whole month.

Our senior neighbors like Mary, who live on a fixed income, are at a huge disadvantage when faced with unforeseen costs like medical

emergencies or skyrocketing inflation rates. When a budget is already stretched as thin as a willow, a helping hand is essential to ensuring they are able to eat a nutritious meal without sacrificing prescription medicine, utilities and other essentials.

Fortunately, Mary heard about the Central Texas Food Bank from friends who told her she had to help neighbors stay healthy by providing nourishing food at no cost. At the Food Bank, Mary gets produce and pantry staples, and even picks up food for her neighbors, too.

"It's a blessing to be able to help others," she says.

Now, Mary and her neighbors can cook vegetables like carrots and add them to meals. The Food Bank makes it easier on Mary and community members like her when it comes time to pay bills.

To our donors who make support like this possible, Mary says, "I just appreciate [you] so much."

Thank you for the incredible support you make available to our neighbors facing hunger through your generous gifts. We are truly proud to call you a partner in the important work we do together.

A Step Forward for Military Families Facing Hunger

In December 2021, Congress passed the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) including funding for the defense budget and military in Fiscal Year 2022. For the first time, the NDAA includes a provision for a Basic Needs Allowance, providing much-needed assistance for the most vulnerable military families. Last year, approximately fourteen percent of military families in the enlisted ranks reported having visited a food bank, and one third of military teens reported being worried about their families having enough food.

Central Texas is home to Fort Hood, the nation's largest active duty armored service post. Nearly 40,000 soldiers work on the post and live in the surrounding communities served by the Food Bank and our Partner Agency network. Prior to and over the course of the pandemic, our partners around Fort Hood reported growing numbers of active-duty families accessing their services.

A recent report published by the Military Family Advisory Network (MFAN) indicated that Texas ranks the highest in the country for food insecurity in military families, with one in six qualifying as food insecure. The highest concentration of these families is in the Killeen, Texas, area and includes active-duty members, veterans and retirees.

With the inclusion of the Basic Needs Allowance in this year's NDAA, many of these families will receive the critical assistance they need to feed their families. Under the new program, enlisted families whose income and household size put them below 100% of the federal poverty guidelines will be eligible to apply for assistance.

Additionally, the NDAA program allows the Secretary of Defense to exclude a portion of the military Basic Housing Allowance to expand eligibility to families stationed in high-cost areas like Central Texas. This small pay boost will make a big difference for military families struggling to make ends meet and marks an important step in reducing hunger for enlisted Central Texans.

"There are some nights where you have Ramen noodles, and the kids say, 'what, again?'" Amy says of her family's financial situation. "It's been humbling."

When her husband fractured his spine, the couple's income dropped by about 75 percent. He worked as a driver but suddenly couldn't even walk for six months. He started doing odd jobs to provide for their growing children, but the pay was nowhere near his former income.

Although it's been a couple years and the challenges keep mounting in the face of the COVID-19 outbreak, Amy says she believes things will soon look up — thanks in part to your support. Amy's husband is a veteran, so their family receives food at All Faiths Food Bank's Veteran's Pantry.

Low-Carb Turkey Stuffing Waffles

Looking for a creative way to use that leftover turkey and cranberry sauce? These "stuffing waffles" require very few ingredients and are made of things you probably already have at home!



Total Time: 5 minutes prep
5 minutes cook

Yield: 4 servings

Ingredients:

- 2 eggs, beaten
- ½ cup mozzarella, shredded
- ½ cup Parmesan cheese, grated
- ¼ teaspoon onion powder
- ¼ teaspoon poultry seasoning
- ½ cup turkey, cooked and diced
- 1 tablespoon butter

Directions:

1. Heat up your waffle iron and melt a little butter in the microwave.
2. Mix all remaining ingredients in a large bowl.
3. Use the butter to grease the waffle iron. Take out ¼ of the batter and add to the center of the waffle iron. Close the lid and wait until done. NOTE: This recipe makes 4 smaller waffles. The smaller waffles work best in the waffle iron, so don't try to make one big one as it will be hard to get out.
4. Top with turkey, cranberry sauce or whatever you like!

Turkey Stew

Have all the ingredients from holiday favorites still sitting in your fridge? Put them to good use by making this easy turkey stew!

Total Time: 15 minutes prep
45 minutes cook

Yield: 4 servings

Ingredients:

- 2 teaspoons canola oil
- ½ large onion
- 4 carrots
- 2 celery stalks
- 1 garlic clove
- 1 can (15-ounce) diced tomatoes
- 2 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 2 cups cooked, chopped turkey
- ½ teaspoon Italian seasoning or fresh herbs to taste

Directions:

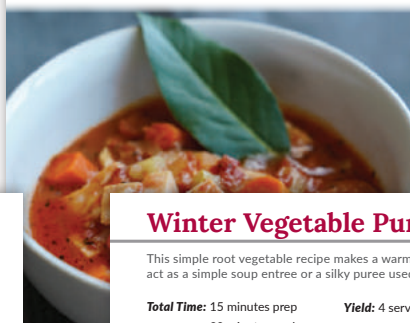
1. Wash all vegetables. Wipe off tops of cans.
2. Chop onion, carrots, celery and potatoes. Mince garlic.
3. Heat oil in large pot. Add onion, carrots, celery and garlic. Sauté for 2 minutes.
4. Add potatoes, tomatoes and broth to pan. Bring to a boil, then lower heat and simmer 30 minutes or until vegetables are tender.
5. Add turkey and Italian herbs and cook another five minutes
6. Season to taste and enjoy!

Winter Vegetable Puree

This simple root vegetable recipe makes a warm, hearty comforting soup that can act as a simple soup entree or a silky puree used as a base for another dish.

Total Time: 15 minutes prep
30 minutes cook

Yield: 4 servings

Ingredients:

- 2 pounds various winter vegetables, such as butternut squash, turnips, rutabagas, carrots, parsnips, potatoes and celery root
- ½ cup milk
- 2 tablespoons butter
- Salt and black pepper to taste.

Directions:

1. Wash all the vegetables.
2. Peel and cut the vegetables into 2-inch cubes. Place in cold, salted water. Chop dense vegetables into smaller pieces to speed up cooking time.
3. Bring to a boil and cook the vegetables for 25 to 40 minutes. You'll know they're done when they're tender when pierced with a fork.
4. Drain and mash the vegetables.
5. Return the mashed vegetables to stove top and heat. Add the milk, butter, salt and pepper.
6. Serve hot.
